SKCTC actively pursues a mission of transfer for our students who have their sights set on a baccalaureate degree or higher. We encourage students to transfer and provide support for those planning to do so.

In an effort to make the pursuit of a baccalaureate degree more feasible for our students, we have partnered with several colleges who now offer degree programs on our campus. This means that our students can attain a baccalaureate degree without having to move away. Since many of our students have families and jobs, these types of programs have been especially helpful and successful.

Two examples are listed in the table below. We have enjoyed a long-standing positive relationship with Lincoln Memorial University, who has brought its Education and Business programs to our main campus. We have partnered with Lindsey Wilson College since 2000, and they offer a baccalaureate degree in Human Services and a Master's degree in Counseling, both on our main campus.

To measure the success of our transfer function, we look at several indicators. According to the data contained in the table below, the majority of the students that transfer to these institutions end up completing a 4-year degree. The strongest indicator of our transfer students' success, however, is that they earn a higher GPA than the general student population at the transfer institution. We are actively seeking this type of data from all of the institutions where our students transfer. We are utilizing the National Student Clearinghouse as well to track our transfers, but the Clearinghouse does not track GPA.
